A Reflection From: Deacon Chris Nocchi



You were chosen by God and set apart for a very special purpose. To go out and prophesy about the Kingdom of God, about the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, to Share the Good News. You have been set apart by God. Called from whatever vocation you live, whether service person, health care professional, accountant, or construction worker. All are called to prophesy to God's plan.

God has instilled in you all that you need to share the Good News. He has placed within you His very nature and as such gives you the ability to speak to the future of His Kingdom. God has made known to you, His people, His will, and His favor. He has given His people special wisdom and insight through the messages of Jesus and His Church. And so, the question is then, have you accepted the mission from God? Are you working in the area that He has sent you to, to heal those in pain and confusion. To help deliver those suffering from addiction, homelessness, or loneliness. Are you willing to cast out the evil ideas of prejudice, hedonism and selfishness that affect our communities.

Let us prepare for our mission by discerning God's will, meditating on the Good News of Jesus Christ, and evaluating and understanding our own beliefs. Also, let us understand how we will deal with rejection. When Jesus was preparing His disciples to go out and speak in His name, He told them that they will be rejected. And so, we know that we will be rejected. He instructs us on what we are to do. Jesus tells us to shake the dust from our sandals. What does this mean? We are not to confront with anger or threats or self-righteous indignation. When He tells us to shake the dust off, He means that we should shake off our frustration, our sadness, our confusion and move to the next community. By doing this we avoid the temptation to keep score on who we have won for Christ and whom we feel we have lost. It moves the focus from our own mission to God's mission for us.

How wonderful it is to lift our hearts with others in prophesying the good news of Jesus in these confusing and threatening times. If we can share with those around us the promises of Christ, we begin to drive out fear, heal the broken hearted, lift up those paralyzed by indifference and help others to see the plan of God.

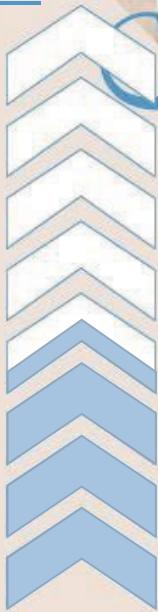

Pierwsze czytanie z Księgi Amosa (Am 7,12-15)

Amazjasz, kapłan w Betel, rzekł do Amosa: Widzący, idź, uciekaj sobie do ziemi Judy! I tam jedz chleb, i tam prorokuj! A w Betel więcej nie prorokuj, bo jest ono królewską świątynią i królewską budowlą. I odpowiedział Amos Amazjaszowi: Nie jestem ja prorokiem ani nie jestem uczniem proroków, gdyż jestem pasterzem i tym, który nacina sykomorę. Od trzody bowiem wziął mnie Pan i rzekł do mnie Pan: Idź, prorokuj do narodu mego, izraelskiego!

Drugie czytanie z Listu św. Pawła do Efezjan (Ef 1,3-14)

Niech będzie błogosławiony Bóg i Ojciec Pana naszego Jezusa Chrystusa; który napenił nas wszelkim błogosławieństwem duchowym na wyżynach niebieskich - w Chrystusie. W Nim bowiem wybrał nas przez założeniem świata, abyśmy byli święci i nieskalani przed Jego obliczem. Z miłości przeznaczył nas dla siebie jako przybranych synów przez Jezusa Chrystusa, według postanowienia swej woli, ku chwale majestatu swej łaski, którą obdarzył nas w Umiłowanym. W Nim mamy odkupienie przez Jego krew - odpuszczenie występków, według bogactwa Jego łaski. Szczodrze ją na nas wylał w postaci wszelkiej mądrości i zrozumienia, przez to, że nam oznajmił tajemnicę swej woli według swego postanowienia, które przedtem w Nim powziął dla dokonania pełni czasów, aby wszystko na nowo zjednoczyć w Chrystusie jako Głowie: to, co w niebiosach, i to, co na ziemi. W Nim dostąpiliśmy udziału my również, z góry przeznaczeni zamiarem Tego, który dokonuje wszystkiego zgodnie z zamysłem swej woli po to, byśmy istnieli ku chwale Jego majestatu - my, którzyśmy już przedtem nadzieję złożyli w Chrystusie. W Nim także i wy usłyszeliście słowo prawdy, Dobrą Nowinę o waszym zbawieniu. W Nim również uwierzyliście i zostaliście opatrzeni pieczęcią Ducha Świętego, który był obiecany. On jest zadatkiem naszego dziedzictwa w oczekiwaniu na odkupienie, które nas uczyni własnością [Boga], ku chwale Jego majestatu.

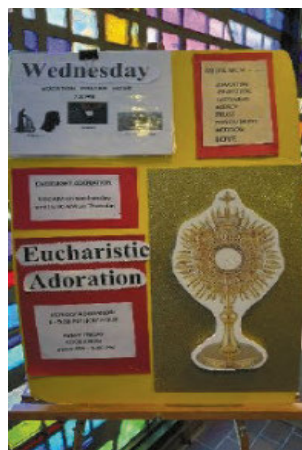
Ewangelia (Mk 6,7-13) Refleksja

Panie, uwolnij mnie od największego mego wroga: ode mnie samego, od nieustannego szukania siebie, swojej woli, swoich spraw, swego wygodnictwa, swego „świętego spokoju”. Uwolnij mnie od ciągłego myślenia o sobie, od pragnienia, by być cenionym, chwalony, wyróżnianym... Od zabiegania o swoje korzyści, o dobra materialne i duchowe, od egoizmu, który wszystkich i wszystko chce skupić wokół swojej osoby, swoich zasług, swoich talentów. Uwolnij mnie od częstego obrażania się na swoje otoczenie, od domagania się usług, od absorbowania innych sobą. Zabij wreszcie to panoszące się moje „ja”, które nie zauważa bliźnich, ich trosk i potrzeb, i nędzy, ich cnót, zasług i talentów, ich prac i poświęcenia. Zachowaj mnie od niedostrzegania w nich Ciebie, Jezusa, który w nich pragniesz być zauważony, uczczony i obsłużony, pocieszony. Zniszcz moją ciasnotę, tępotę i znieczulicę. Rozgrzej moje zimne serce, twarde jak kamień, nieczułe, obojętne kochające tylko siebie i służące bożkowi – mojemu „ja”. Zamień mą chciwość na ofiarność, me skąpstwo na wielkoduszność, mą ciasnotę na życzliwość, mą głupotę na mądrość serca oświeconego światłem Ducha Świętego. Daj, abym wyszedł wreszcie z więzienia własnego „ja” na wolność dzieci Bożych, rozradowanych daniem, dzieleniem się chlebem, czasem, sercem. Tej przemiany możesz dokonać we mnie tylko Ty, który powiedziałeś: „Nie ma większej miłości nad tę, gdy ktoś życie daje za przyjaciół swoich”. Tyś dał życie za mnie i za każdego z bliźnich moich, których postawiłeś na drodze mego życia. Wciągnij mnie w nurt Twej ofiarnej, bezkompromisowej miłości, aby wreszcie skruszyło się moje serce i stopniało, zamieniając się w żar miłości tryskającej z Twego Boskiego Serca i z Twego Boskiego Ducha, którego wylałeś na nas w Wieczerniku Zielonych Świąt. 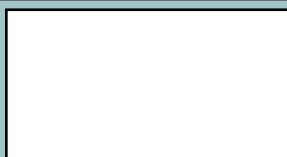



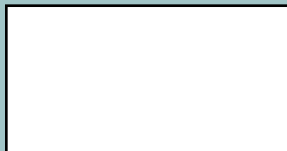
